Safety Equipment:

Life raft: Seago for 4 persons (not serviced), mounted on aft rail
Gas alarm in galley
Radio and TV antennas on mast

Water Systems:

Hot and cold water in both heads and galley
Manual foot pump for cold water in galley
Seawater pumps: outlets at stern, anchor locker, and galley
Holding tank connected to aft toilet

Interior & Comfort:

2 toilets
Stove: 3-burner gas stove with oven
Gas shutoff: mechanical and electric
Fridge and cold box (gas and shore power)
