Designed to be fast, responsive and easy to handle, she is equally suited for family cruising, longer offshore passages and sailors who simply enjoy the pleasure of a well-balanced performance yacht.

This particular X4.9 is presented in exceptionally well-maintained condition and has benefited from a very high level of care by her sole owner since new. During every winter period, the yacht has been stored indoors in a closed hall at X-Yachts in Haderslev, where servicing and maintenance have also been carried out by X-Yachts.

Below deck, the bright Nordic Oak interior creates a warm, modern and spacious atmosphere while retaining the clean Danish styling that characterizes the Pure X range. The three-cabin, two-head layout offers generous accommodation, complemented by a well-equipped galley, spacious saloon and a high level of comfort for both weekends onboard and extended cruising.

The yacht will remain in winter storage at X-Yachts, offering a new owner a particularly convenient opportunity to have additional service work, upgrades or equipment updates carried out before the next sailing season. X-Yachts can offer a wide range of service and upgrade possibilities while the yacht is already in winter storage.
